Environmental Water

Environmental water (e-water) is important for the health of our waterways/wetlands and the life they sustain; animals, plants, people and communities.

An environmental flow (e-flow) is a carefully managed water release to enhance the ecological and human values of waterways:

- Assisting fish movement and breeding
- Improving water quality and riparian vegetation health
- Enhancing bird breeding, feeding and roosting opportunities
- Mimicking natural filling and drying cycles
- Reducing black water and algal bloom risks
