



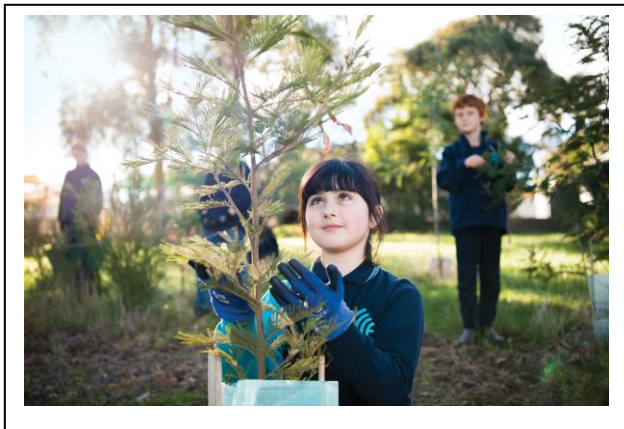
Biodiversity Mini Workshop
